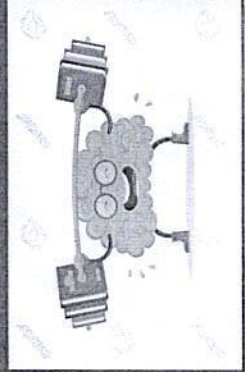

Clean Environment and our role

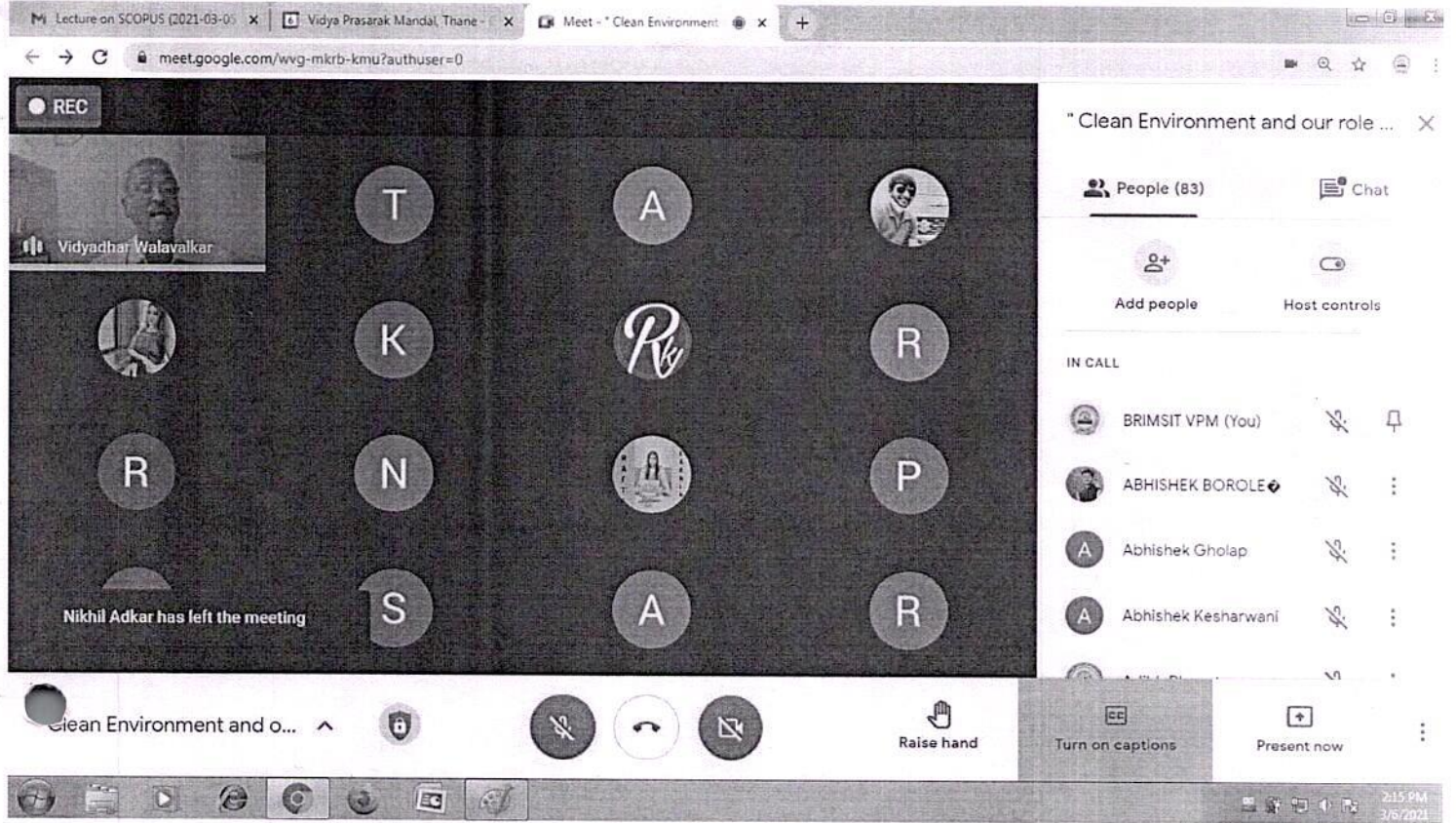

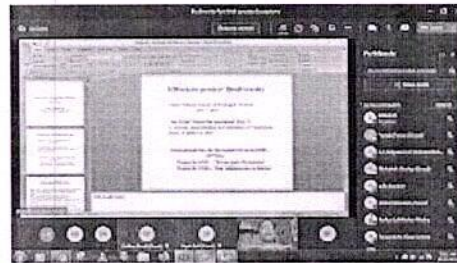
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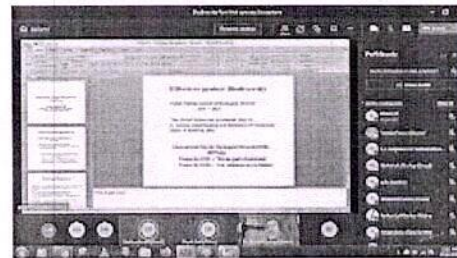
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Guidance on psychosocial skill to helpers during Pandemic

On May 27, 2021, Jayshree Jain from the Mahatma Gandhi National Council of Rural Education (MGNCRE) provided guidance on psychological skills for helpers during the pandemic. 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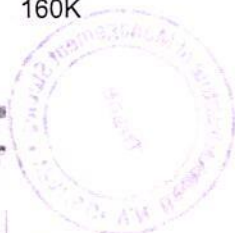


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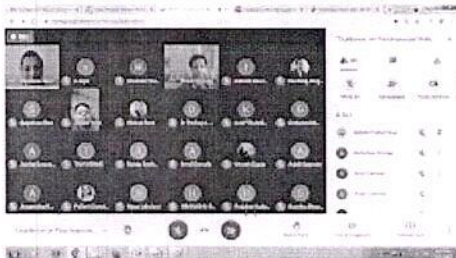
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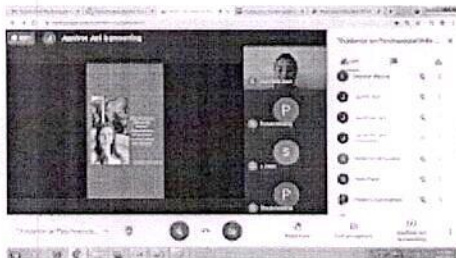




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Plastic Pollution and our Role
