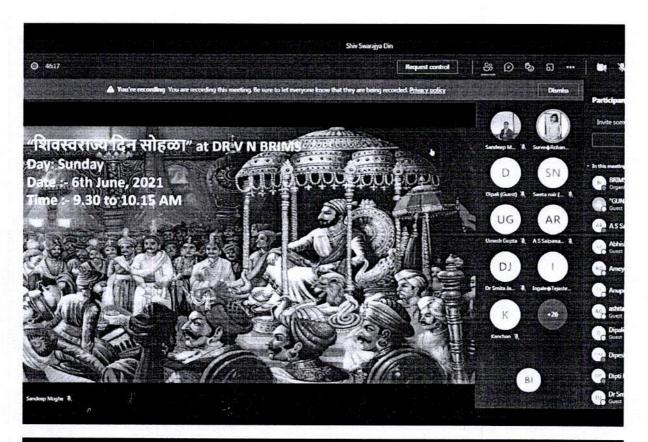

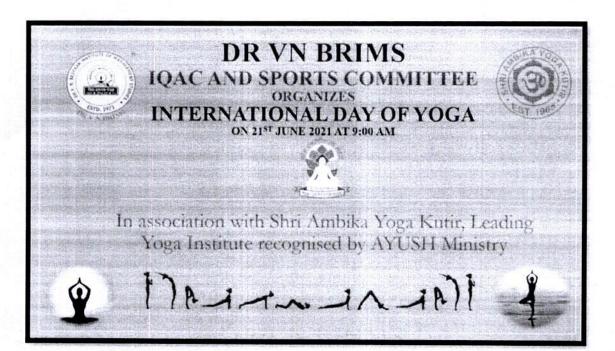

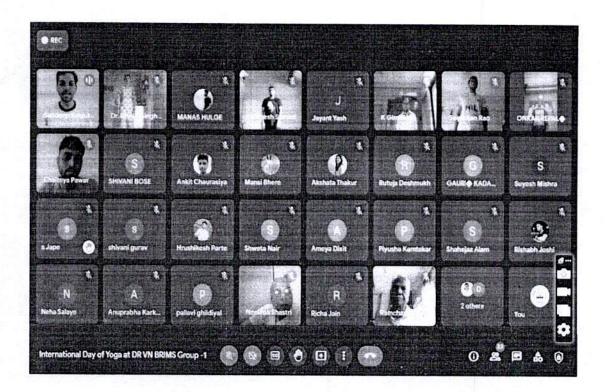
International Yoga Day Celebration at BRIMS

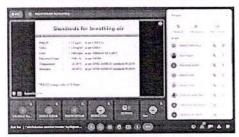

Poster Making Competition on "National Energy Conservation" at BRIMS

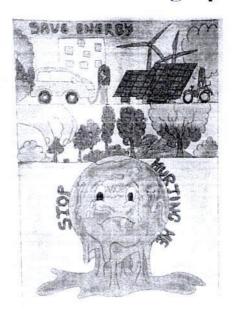

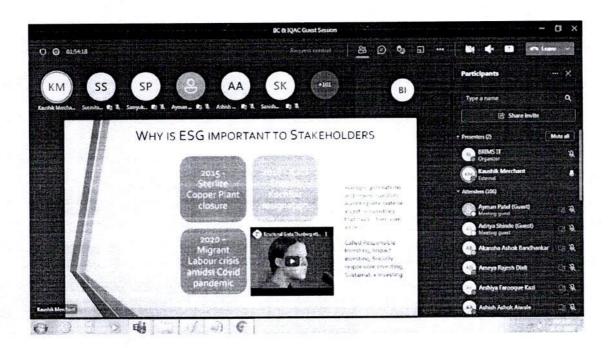

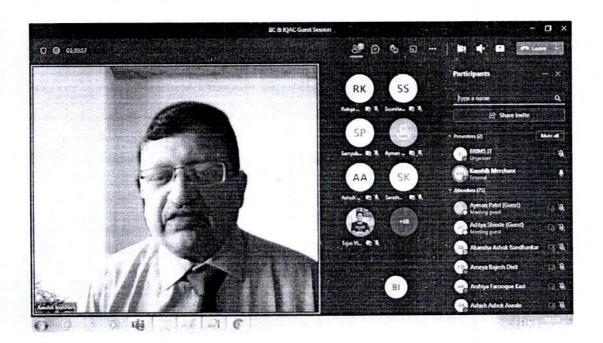
Guest Session on "Sustainability and Social Relevance of Business" at BRIMS

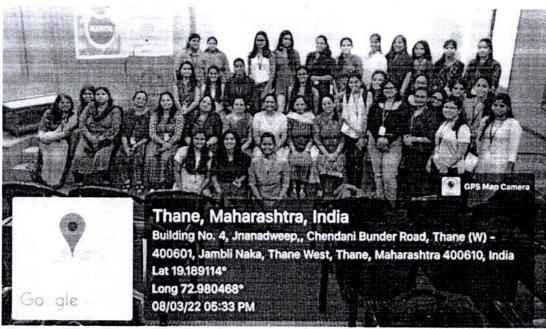
International Women's Day Celebrations at DR VN BRIMS

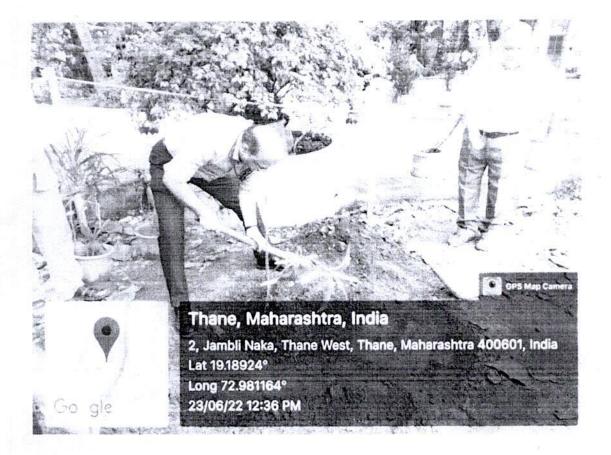
