
Panchpran Pledge

		was designed to address the growing need for effective
		communication skills in academic and professional settings.
		Initially, the students appeared hesitant to participate,
		displaying a common reluctance often observed in such
		workshops. Recognizing this, Asst. Prof. Tawade began with
		an ice-breaking session to create a more comfortable and
		engaging atmosphere. This approach proved successful, as



students gradually opened up and began interacting more freely.

As the session progressed, students started sharing their challenges related to public speaking. Common issues raised included fear of speaking in front of an audience, lack of confidence in English language skills, and uncertainty about proper body language and voice modulation. Prof. Tawade addressed these concerns, providing practical tips and strategies to overcome these hurdles.

The importance of English language proficiency was emphasized, highlighting its role in academic success and future career prospects. Prof. Tawade stressed that regular practice and exposure to English through various media can significantly improve language skills.

Regarding public speaking, the session covered key points such as:

- 1) Proper preparation on the topic
- Organizing thoughts and creating a clear structure for presentations
- Techniques for managing nervousness and building confidence
- 4) The significance of body language and voice modulation
- 5) Engaging the audience through interactive elements

Students were encouraged to practice these skills regularly, both in and outside the classroom. The session also included short exercises where volunteers attempted impromptu speeches, receiving constructive feedback from Prof. Tawade and their peers.



The event was well-received by both students and school authorities. It marks a promising start to the collaboration between our college and Mankoli Village, demonstrating the potential impact of such skill-based initiatives on rural education.

This initiative aligns with our institute's commitment to social responsibility and community development, bridging the gap between urban and rural educational opportunities.
