Title: To study the Impact of Augmented Reality on Behavioral Intention of consumers towards Green Products in Retail Store.

Purpose: The study aims to understand consumers' behavioral intention towards AR-enabled Green products.

Research Design and Methodology:

- Research model: TAM
- Procedure: AR-based Suggestion app
- Data collection method: Questionnaire
- Sampling: Convenience sampling
- Data analysis: SEM using Smart PLS
- Design: Cross-sectional and Descriptive
- Scope: Restricted to Thane region

Objectives:

- To Analyse Consumer Behavior towards Augmented Reality using the Technology acceptance model.
- To study the relationship between I-AR, ATT, PR and BIUG variables.

Theoretical framework and Hypothesis:

H1(+VE): I-AR → ATT (+VE)
H2(+VE): I-AR → BIUG (+VE)
H3(+VE): ATT → BIUG (+VE)
H4: ATT has significant positive impact on BIUG.
H5: I-AR has significant positive impact on BIUG.
H6: ATT moderates the relationship between I-AR and BIUG.
H7: PR moderates the relationship between I-AR and BIUG.

For each construct: $\alpha < 0.7$, CR (alpha) > 0.7 , AVE > 0.5 . Hence, convergent validity was acceptable.

ATT fully mediates relation between I-AR and BIUG.

Conclusion and Implications: The application of AR in the retail business has the potential to eliminate the information gap at the point of sale and a consumer's behavioral intention towards Green products. This study will benefit Researchers, Small and Large business, Marketers and Customers.
